2009 H1N1 Flu Pandemic Officially Over

(Aug 11, 2010) The World Health Organization declared that the 2009 H1N1 influenza pandemic is officially over, but that the strain will likely take on features of a seasonal flu virus.

WHO offered guidance for how to manage the virus during the post-pandemic period. Certain groups (e.g., young children, pregnant women, and people with respiratory or chronic conditions) will likely remain at elevated risk for severe illness in the immediate future. Such high-risk individuals should receive the trivalent flu vaccine, where available, or the monovalent H1N1 vaccine.

DRG Logic Change: Newborns

- V64.05 - Vaccination not carried out because of caregiver refusal

- When assigned as an additional diagnosis will group to MS-DRG 795 Normal Newborn instead of MS-DRG 794 Neonate with other significant problems
 - MS-DRG 795 (wt. .1617) vs. MS-DRG 794 (wt. 1.2181)

DRG Logic Change: Newborns

- All newborn cases assigned to MS-DRGs 790 through 795 and identified with discharge status 05 will be reassigned to MS-DRG 789 for transferred neonates.
 - Discharge Status code 05: (Discharged/transferred to a designated cancer center or children's hospital)
 - MS-DRG 789 Neonates, Died or Transferred To Another Acute Care Facility

25 Diagnoses and Procedures

- Currently: Hospitals can submit up to 25 Dx and 25 Px; however, CMS' current system limitations allow for the processing of only the first 9 Dx and 6 Px.
- Extensive system updates as part of the move to 5010 and the ability to accept ICD-10 codes, will include the ability to process more Dx and Px codes.
- For claims submitted in the 5010 format beginning January 1, 2011: CMS will increase the capacity on hospital inpatient claims to 25 Dx and 25 Px.
- Multiple uses for the additional information provided by this coded data: payment, quality measures, outcome analysis, etc.

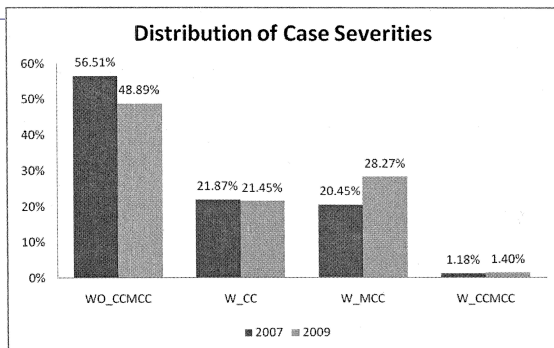

The word "with" should be interpreted to mean "associated with" or "due to" when it appears in a code title, the Alphabetic Index, or an instructional note in the Tabular List.

Changes to: ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting

- Page 28
- (i) **Secondary diabetes mellitus due to pancreatectomy**
For postpancreatectomy diabetes mellitus (lack of insulin due to the surgical removal of all or part of the pancreas), assign code 251.3, Postsurgical hypoinsulinemia. Assign a code from subcategory 249, **Secondary diabetes mellitus and a code from subcategory V88.1, Acquired absence of pancreas** as additional codes. Code also any diabetic manifestations (e.g. diabetic nephrosis 581.81).

b. Cerebral infarction/stroke/cerebrovascular accident (CVA)

The terms stroke and CVA are often used interchangeably to refer to a cerebral infarction. The terms stroke, CVA, and cerebral infarction NOS are all indexed to the default code 434.91, Cerebral artery occlusion, unspecified, with infarction.

Additional code(s) should be assigned for any neurologic deficits associated with the acute CVA, regardless of whether or not the neurologic deficit resolves prior to discharge.

Status codes indicate that a patient is a carrier of a disease, has the sequelae or residual of a past disease or condition, or has another factor influencing a person's health status.

This code may be used when it is documented by the provider that a patient is on do not resuscitate status at any time during the stay.

V49.87 Physical restraint status

This code may be used when it is documented by the provider that a patient has been put in restraints during the current encounter. Please note that this code should not be reported when it is documented by the provider that a patient is temporarily restrained during a procedure
